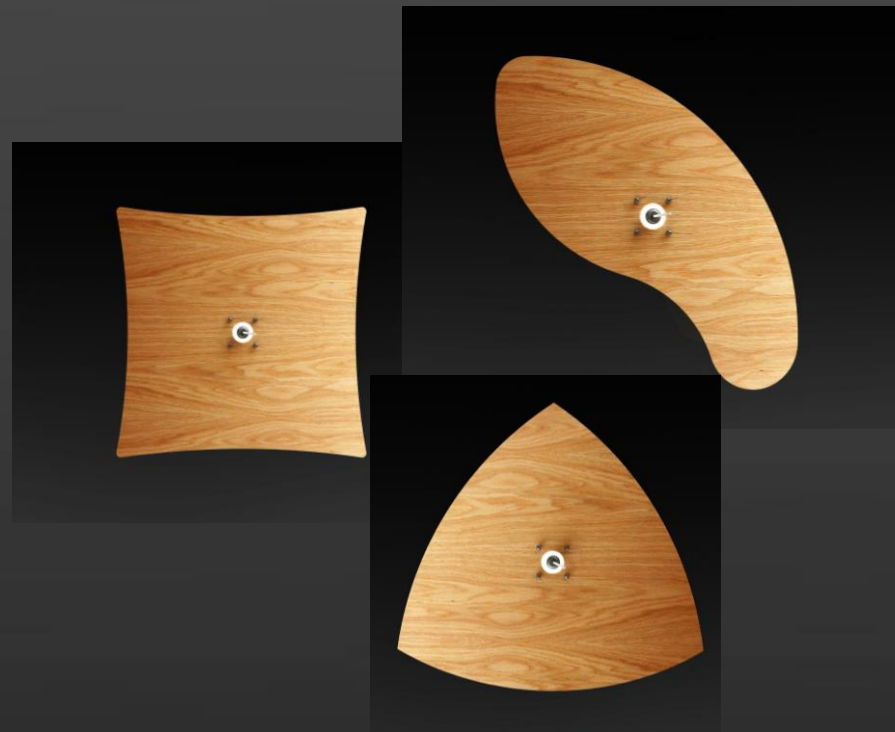

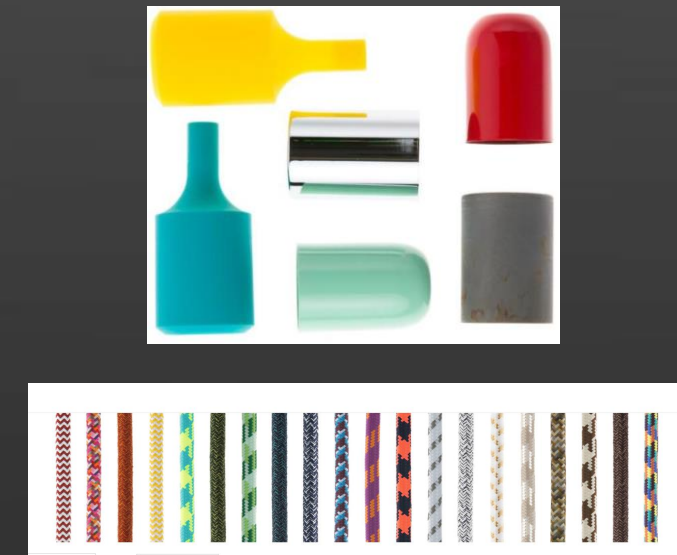
Select/create a shape



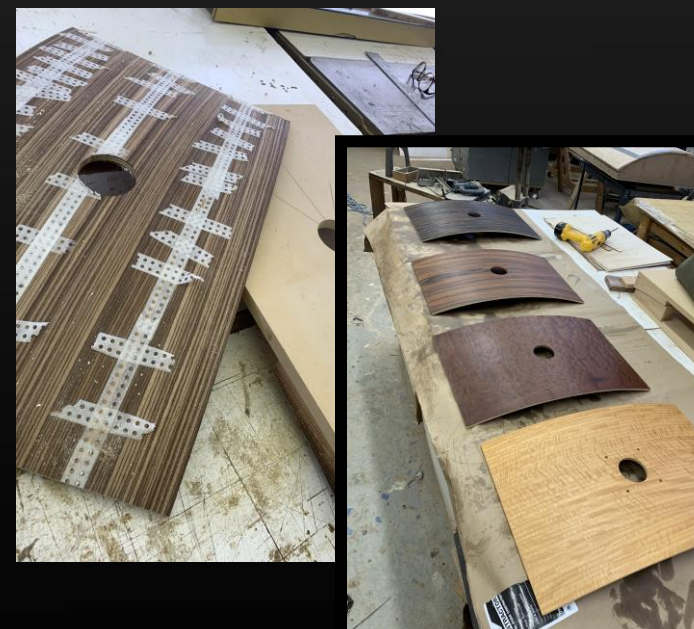
Select a veneer



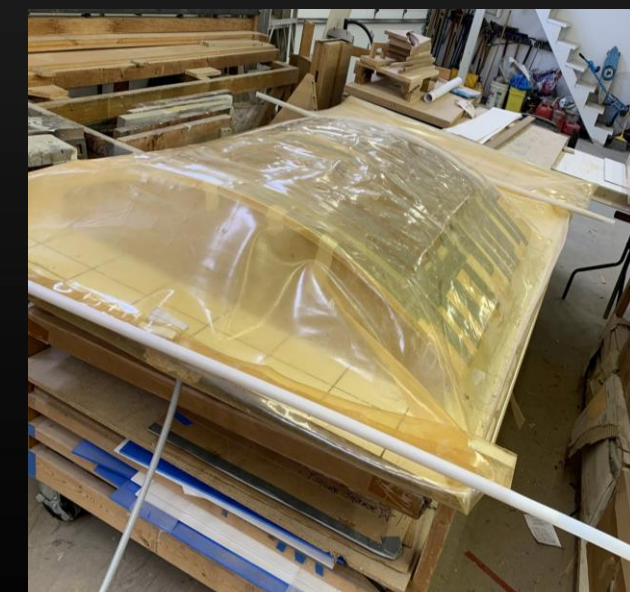
Select socket cover and power cord aesthetic

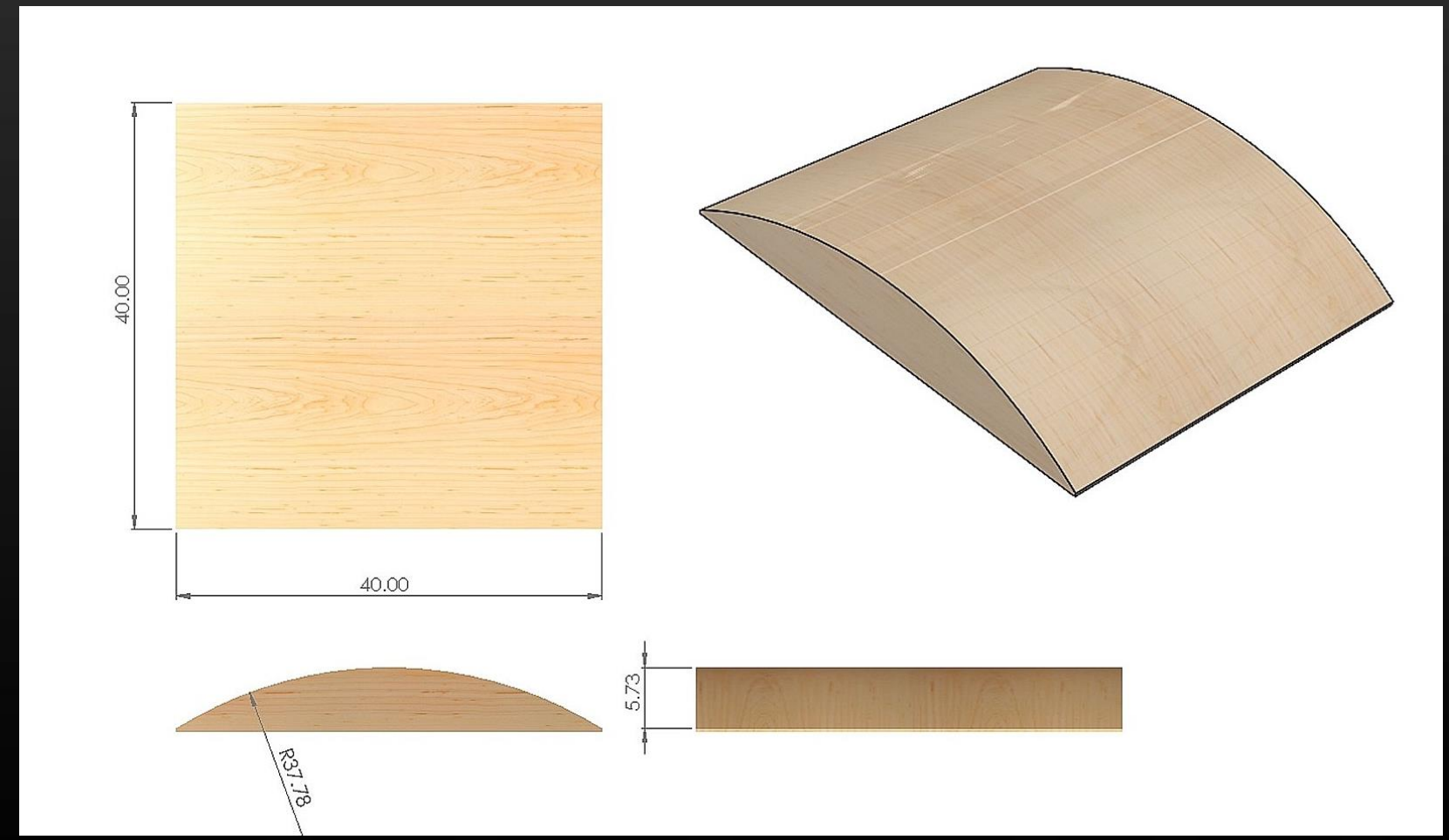
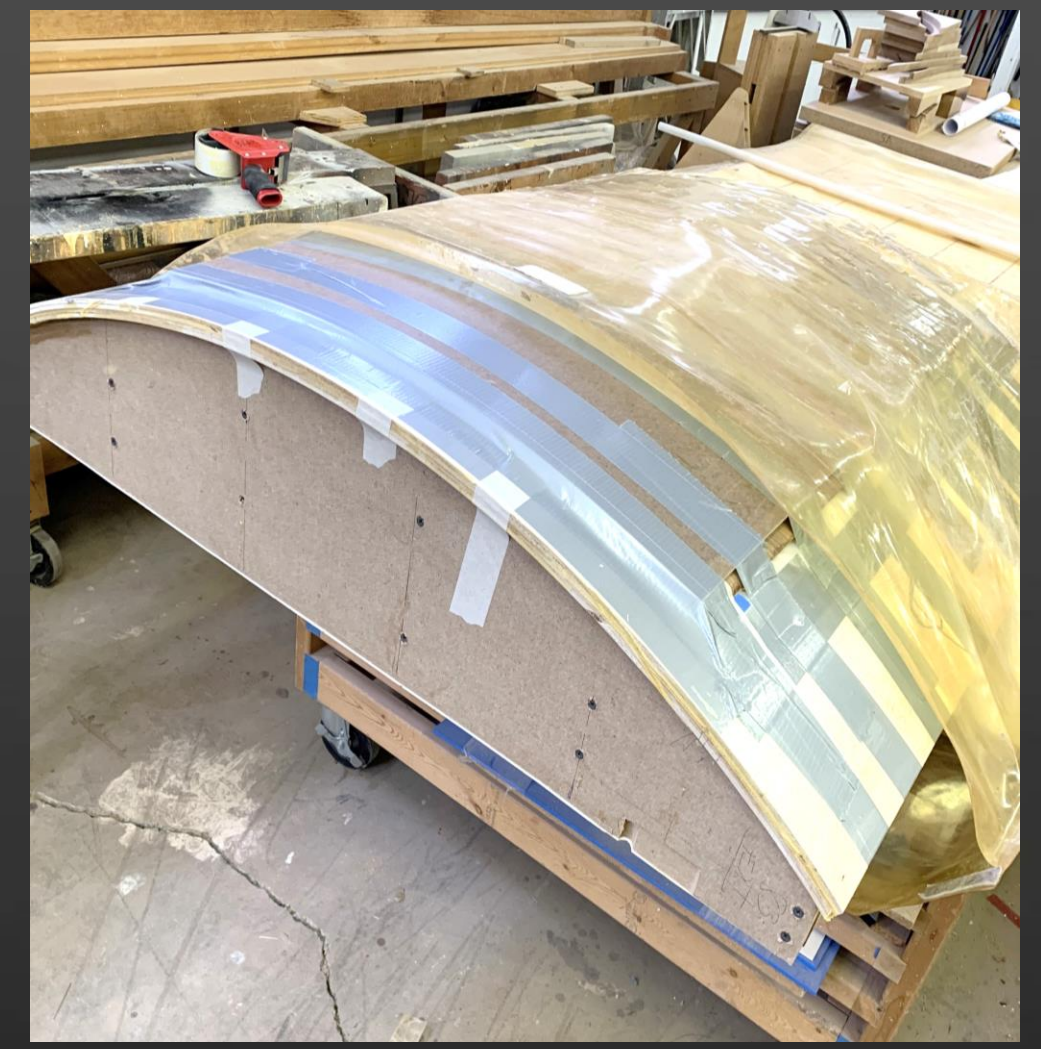

Customizing the Wood Veneer Arc Light

Shape/form options

- unlimited shapes/forms within the 40" x 40" veneer format size

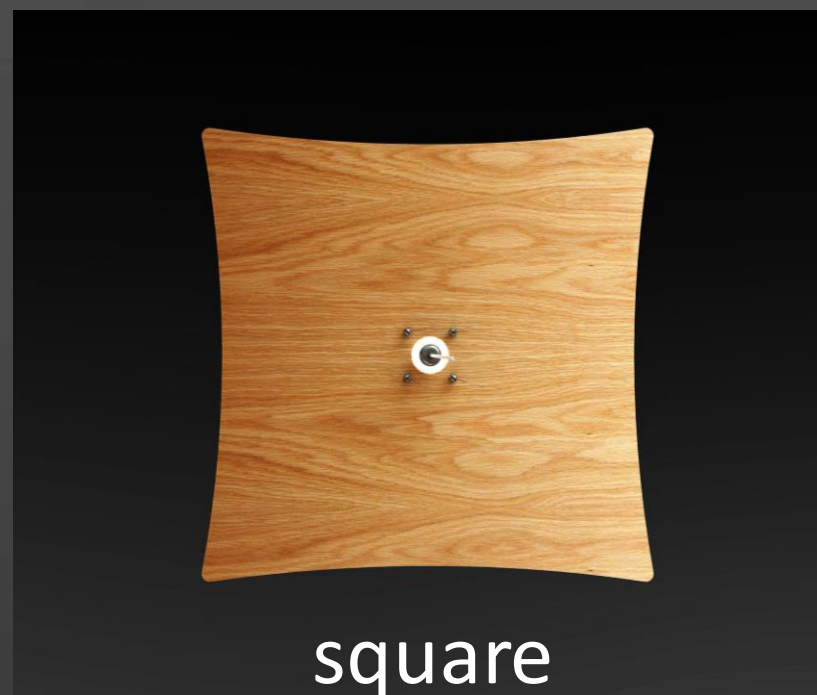
Working from a 40" x 40" veneering form, a multitude of shapes can be derived. From the standard 15" x 24" rectangle arc light form, the 40" mold form yields other simple geometric and asymmetrical organic shapes with infinite sizes.

Shape/form options

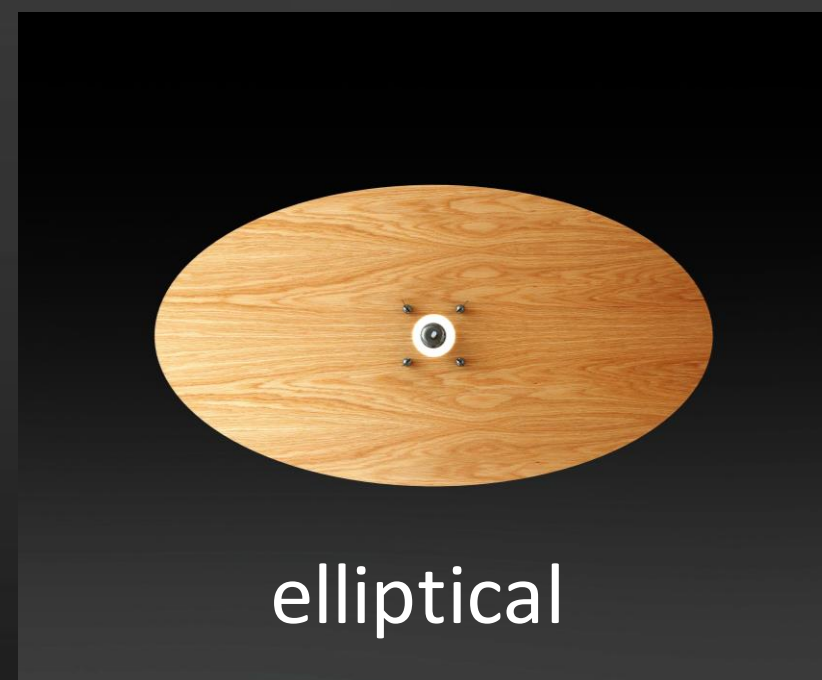
- Rectangular, square, round, elliptical, diamond, triangular and free-form organic are shown only as a reference for possible forms
- However unlimited shapes/forms within the 40" x 40" veneer press form size are possible



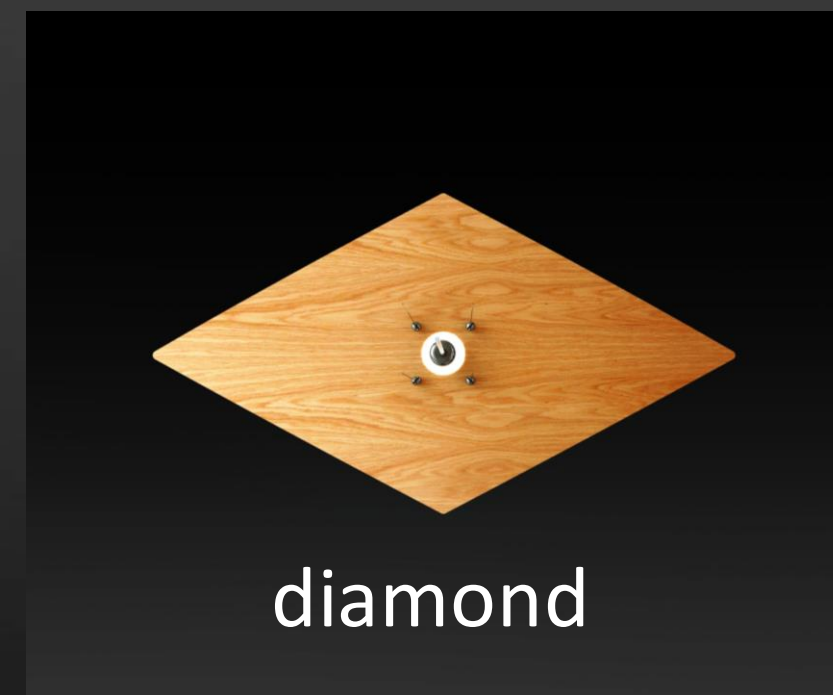

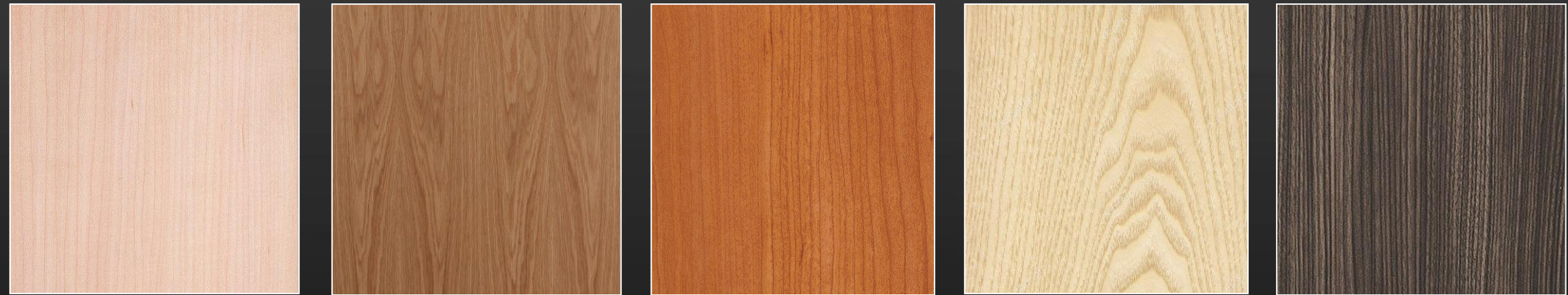
Wood Veneer options

- Standard domestic & exotic species offered on 15" x 24" production rectangular shape
- Note: Unlimited species and veneer layup patterns are available on Custom Design Series

While (5) Domestic wood veneers and (5) Exotic wood veneers are standard on the 15" x 24" (rectangular) wood veneer arc light (below) and priced accordingly, unlimited veneer choices can be specified. Pricing will reflect the current market cost of the selected veneer.



Domestic standard wood veneer options include maple, red oak, cherry, white oak, and walnut.



Exotic standard wood veneer options include ebony, zebrawood, anigre, santos rosewood, and pommele sapele.

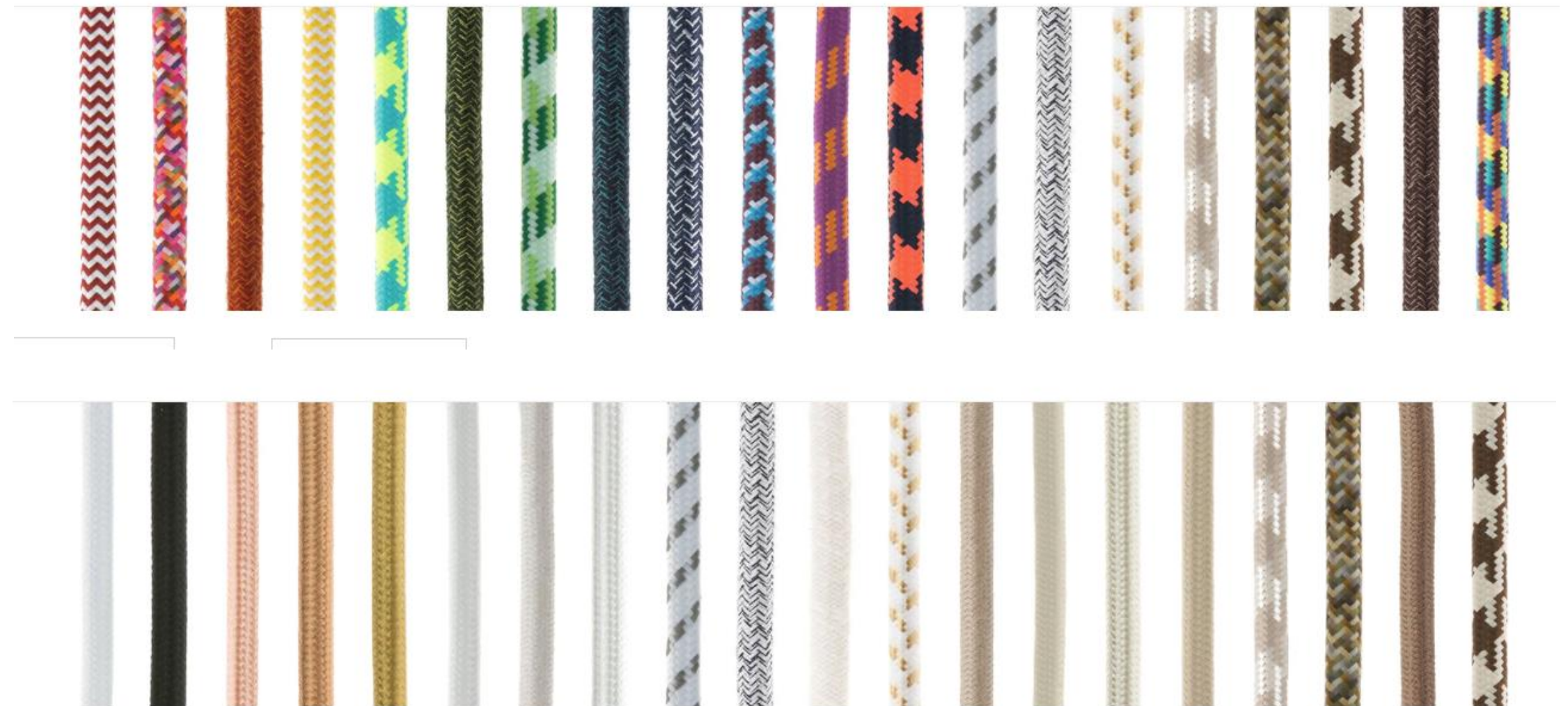

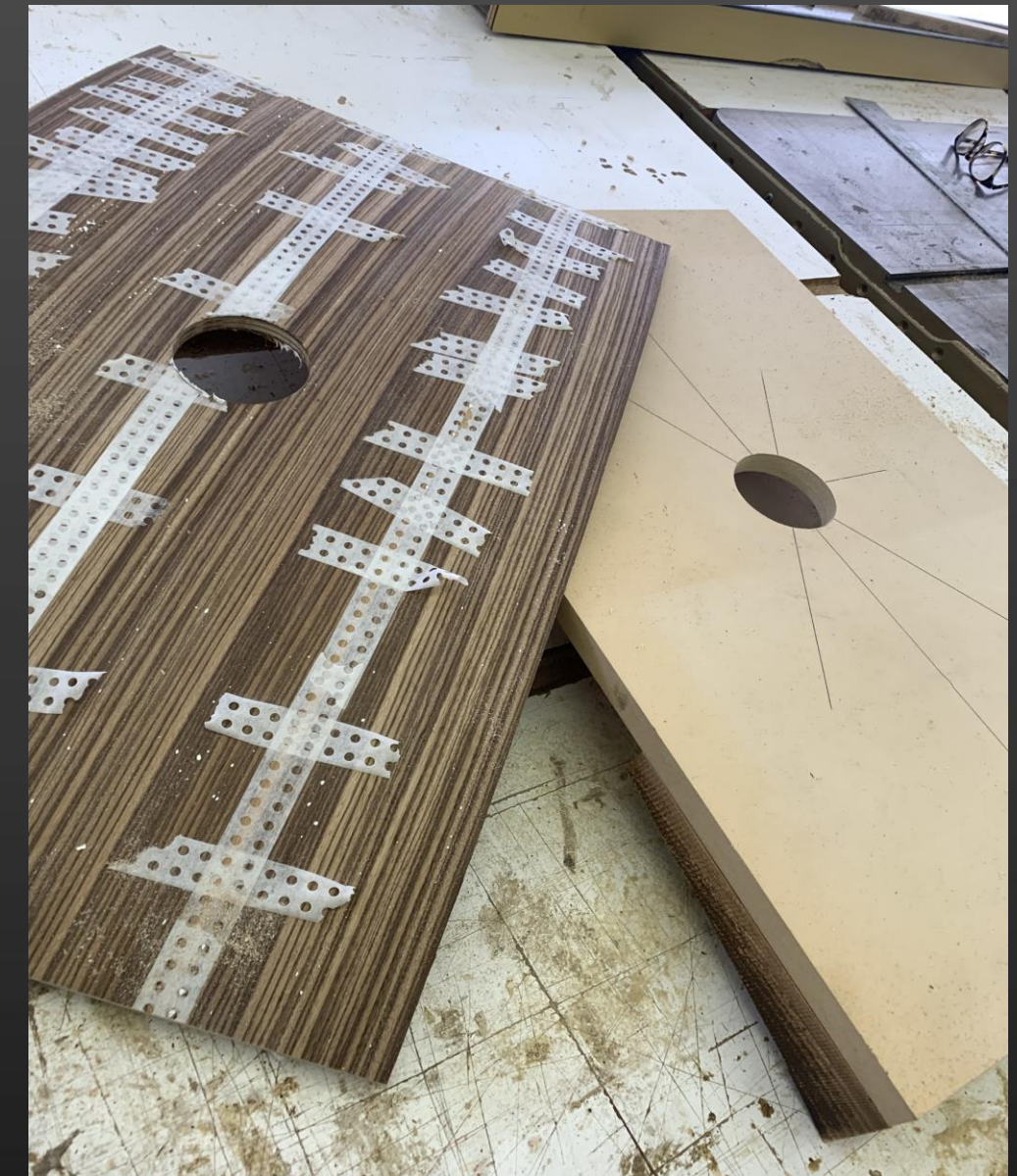

From the vacuum press the light forms are cut to size and drilled and machined for hardware



Custom stain match and finish topcoats available beyond Danish Oil hand rubbed finish

How to get started?

5. What kind of finish would you prefer; Danish Oil, commercial clear topcoat finish, stain choices etc. Samples can be provided for review for your approval.
